Dear Sergeant Wells and Captain April,

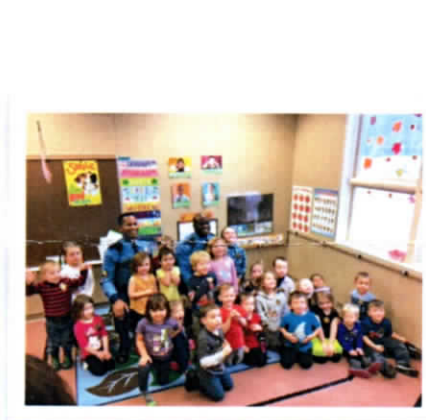
