

Mitchell Davis wins 4-man race for 3rd VP

Chief Mitchell Davis III of the Hazel Crest Police Department won the race for 3rd Vice President of the Illinois Association of Chiefs of Police. Balloting was open for three days this week and ended at 6 p.m. today.

Because all ballots were cast electronically, the results were reviewed immediately by the Board of Officers and the executive director shortly after 6 at the site of the Annual Conference in Peoria. Davis was the winner, and ILACP President James R. Kruger, Jr., notified all four candidates at the same time about the outcome of the election.

Davis will be sworn in as 3rd VP on Friday night, April 27, at the Installation of Officers at the conclusion of the Annual Conference in Peoria. Davis is slated to become the ILACP president in 2021.
