- ✓ Current students must demonstrate (by transcript) at least a 2.5 GPA;
- ✓ Submit an essay, to include details on how the Award will assist you in your current role as a NOBLE Associate Member, in service to the Community;
- ✓ Completed applications must be received by June 15, 2021, and sent to tege.michelle@gmail.com in a .pdf format.
- ✓ The Award* is valued at \$1,000.00. The full amount will be provided to the Recipient/Post-Secondary Institution once all criteria have been satisfied, and is only awarded to the Recipient once.

The decision process will be conducted by the current NOBLE Associate Member Representative, in collaboration with select Associate Members in good financial standing with NOBLE National, and their Local NOBLE Chapter.

The Award Recipient will be selected from the applications received by the prescribed deadline, and announced prior to the 45th Annual NOBLE Training & Exhibit Conference July 30, 2021 – August 04, 2021, in time for family, friends, colleagues and local Chapter to submit congratulatory remarks on NOBLE social media platforms or a journal ad if Conference is in-person or hybrid.
