COVID-19 Protocol Update

As required by Florida law, Section 381.00316(1), the National Organization of Black Law Enforcement Executives (NOBLE) has lifted its COVID-19 vaccine and mask requirements for registration and attendance at its annual conference, scheduled at The Rosen Shingle Creek Hotel and Resort in Orlando, FL, July 22, 2022 through July 27, 2022.

The governor of Florida and the Florida Department of Health have taken the position that this Florida law makes illegal the COVID-19 mandates for registration and participation at such events in Florida. While NOBLE still encourages all participants to follow CDC guidelines and be vaccinated, tested and to use measures such as masks to reduce the risks of COVID-19 infections, NOBLE is required to comply with Florida law for this conference. Please disregard previous notices regarding COVID-19 mandates and required submission of documentation as a condition for registration and attendance.

Although all mandates are lifted, we encourage all attendees to practice all recommended safety practices. We encourage everyone to take a test 48 hours or less prior to departure for the conference.

During the conference, it is recommended that attendees wear a mask. Masks will be provided to conference attendees. However, all attendees are encouraged to bring a N-95 or KN-95 mask with them as they travel to Orlando, FL.

Hand sanitizer will be provided to each registrant in the registration bag and will be provided in conference areas to include workshop rooms, ballrooms, the exhibit hall, and registration area.

All registrants will be able to select a lanyard color that represents their comfort level with direct engagement. Those who wish to keep a social distance will be given a red lanyard; those who are comfortable with a fist or elbow bump will be provided a yellow lanyard; and those who do not mind being in close proximity or giving a hug will be provided a green lanyard.

- **Orlando International Airport** is a major public airport located 6 miles southeast of Downtown Orlando, Florida. It is the busiest airport in the state and tenth busiest airport in the United States. The Rosen Shingle Creek Hotel is conveniently located minutes away from Orlando International Airport (MCO)

 - Take the north exit from the airport.
 - Take SR 528 West (Beachline Expressway)
 - Take Exit #2 Orangetree Blvd./Universal Blvd.
 - At the end of the exit ramp make a right at the light onto Universal Blvd.
 - Rosen Shingle Creek is immediately on the right, just before the Rosen School of Hospitality Management – UCF.
